ADMISSIONS PROCESS

STEP ONE Online Application and \$150 Application Fee

Magnolia School uses an online service called TADS for Admissions and Enrollment. You can submit your application and the \$150 non-refundable processing fee when applying online. You must set up a TADS account and can login to your account anytime to check on the status of your application.

STEP TWO Required Documents Release of Academic Records Form, Current Transcript and Teacher Evaluation Form(s)

Sign the *Release of Academic Records Form* and submit this to her current school giving them permission to send us her *Current Transcript*. Sign the top of the necessary *Teacher Evaluation Form(s)* giving the teacher permission to email this to us when completed. You can find these forms under the Forms Tab under Admissions on our website. PLEASE NOTE: Those students applying for Grades 2nd-5th must submit one Teacher Evaluation, Grades 6th-8th must submit two (one from her English Teacher and one from her Math Teacher).

STEP THREE Students Applying for Grade 2 Family Interview, Student Assessment Students Applying for Grades 3-8 Family Interview, Student Assessment & Shadow Day

After we have received your completed online application and required documents, you will receive an email inviting you to schedule a Family Interview, student Assessment and Shadow Day. The Family Interview is an opportunity for parents of prospective students along with their daughters to meet with the Admissions Department to discuss the vision, philosophy and environment of Magnolia School. Your daughter will be given student assessments in reading, writing and math to help our faculty determine how to best meet her educational needs. Shadowing a current student is scheduled for a morning or an afternoon and is a requirement for those applying to Grades 3-8.

FINANCIAL AID

Magnolia School uses an online service called TADS to conduct fair and confidential financial need assessments for families that may require assistance paying tuition. TADS will submit their recommendation to Magnolia School based on the application and documents submitted by the family as to what they might be able to reasonably contribute to their daughter's tuition. The Financial Aid Committee at Magnolia School makes the final award decisions after considering all information submitted. All applications submitted by the priority deadline of February 3, 2020 will be considered in the first round of aid disbursement on March 13, 2020. PLEASE NOTE: You must first apply to Magnolia School before applying for Financial Aid.
